

This week we will do something different. I've printed out the Scripture from Sunday's message (Isaiah 6:1-8) and each day focus will be on one or two verses and give you a handful of other passages. Your mission, should you choose to accept it, is to take the Scripture for the day and answer the following four questions:

- What does it say about God?
- What does it say about Human beings?
- What does it say about Creation?
- What does it say about the relationship between creation, God, and humanity?

When you do this, you will engage the Scriptures on a deeper level and be able to make necessary connections between passages. It is also a great exercise when preparing for a Bible study too!

Isaiah 6 In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord sitting on a throne, high and lofty; and the hem of his robe filled the temple. ² Seraphs were in attendance above him; each had six wings: with two they covered their faces, and with two they covered their feet, and with two they flew. ³ And one called to another and said:

“Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of hosts;
the whole earth is full of his glory.”

⁴ The pivots on the thresholds shook at the voices of those who called, and the house filled with smoke. ⁵ And I said: “Woe is me! I am lost, for I am a man of unclean lips, and I live among a people of unclean lips; yet my eyes have seen the King, the Lord of hosts!”

⁶ Then one of the seraphs flew to me, holding a live coal that had been taken from the altar with a pair of tongs. ⁷ The seraph touched my mouth with it and said: “Now that this has touched your lips, your guilt has departed and your sin is blotted out.” ⁸ Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, “Whom shall I send, and who will go for us?” And I said, “Here am I; send me!”

Monday November 14th – Focus on Isaiah 6:1-2 and look at 2 Kings 15:7, Numbers 12:8, John 12:41, Revelation 4:2, and Ezekiel 10:15.

Tuesday, November 15th – Focus on Isaiah 6:3-4 and look at Psalm 89:8, Malachi 1:11, Numbers 17:12, and Revelation 4:8.

Wednesday, November 16th – Focus on Isaiah 6:5 and look at Jeremiah 9:3-8, Luke 5:8

Thursday, November 17th – Focus on Isaiah 6:6 and look at Leviticus 10:1, Job 42:5, and Ezekiel 10:2

Friday, November 18th – Focus on Isaiah 6:7 and look at Jeremiah 1:9, Daniel 12:3, and 1 John 1:7

Saturday, November 19th – Focus on Isaiah 6:8 and look at Job 40:9, Acts 9:4, and Jeremiah 26:12, 15.

Consider each day what you have learned and how that might shape your prayer for your relationship to God, with other people, with creation. Pray for those in need as listed below each day:
