Below is a list of classroom rules and behavior management. We have been going over them daily with the children; please go over these with them at home as well.

Classroom Rules:

- No looking over the upstairs balcony.
- Raise your hand when needing to speak or to get out of your seat.
- ♦ Keep your hands to yourself.
- Listen when the teachers are talking.
- Survey Use one squirt of soap and no more than two paper towels to dry your hands.

Behavior Management:

- If a child is having trouble following rules or directions, they will be told what they were doing and why we don't do that at school.
- If they continue to have trouble, they will take a time out or be removed from the group and will lose their sticker for that day.
- If your child has a sticker on their hand, that means they followed directions and rules that day. If not, that means they struggled to follow the rules that day.
